An application has been made to the Registration Authority, Buckinghamshire Council, Walton Street Offices, Walton Street, Aylesbury ('the Registration Authority') by John Patterson, The Cottage, Innings Road, Little Freith, RG9 6NR ('the applicant') under section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 ('the Act') and in accordance with The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008 ('the Regulations').

The application seeks to correct a mistake made by the commons registration authority in wrongly registering land as Common Land on the 4th September 1972 and hatched purple on the accompanying plan. It is considered that the land registered as CL217 formed part of the curtilage of "The Cottage" at the time of registration and the Parish Council clerk mistakenly informed the County Surveyor that the Parish Council owned the land. If the application is accepted the commons registration authority will remove CL217 from the register of common land.
