Observers

The Electoral Commission reserves the right to send representatives to observe the Count. These will be identified by pink badges. Accredited observers will wear white badges.

Arrangements for Candidates and Agents

We are conducting a combined poll. All ballot papers for Buckinghamshire Council's 49 wards and the 53 contested Town and Parish Council areas will be verified and counted at Stoke Mandeville Stadium, Guttman Road, Aylesbury HP21 9PP.

Details of where each ward and ballot box will be found at the venue are included at Appendix 2 & 3

Verification

Candidates, Agents and Count Agents will have an unrestricted view of the verification and count proceedings. They must remain out of the secure staff areas and not interfere with the work of count staff. They are able to sit or stand opposite the count staff to observe proceedings but are not permitted to handle the ballot papers. They may inspect the face of any ballot paper, but not the number on the back.

Please note that any questions should be directed to count supervisors, and not count assistants. To help you identify supervisors, they will be wearing white vests or bibs.

Doubtful Ballots Adjudication

Once ballot papers have been sorted, by the Doubtful Ballot Paper Adjudication Officers, a Deputy Acting Returning Officer will adjudicate doubtful ballot papers. Candidates and agents will be able to inspect each doubtful ballot paper and the DAROs decision. Each ballot paper will be stamped to confirm the decision. If a candidate/agent disagrees with the DARO decision, that will be noted. A copy of the doubtful ballot paper guidance will be on display for reference.

Declaration of results

Once the Returning Officer is satisfied with the accuracy of the Count, a provisional result will be shared with the candidates and agents, at the count table for that seat. At this point, candidates and agents are entitled to request a recount. Any recount is at the discretion of the RO (see below).

If there should be an equal number of votes for two candidates with the highest number of votes, the outcome will be determined by the RO drawing lots. The drawing of lots will take place at the count table for that seat by Sarah Ashmead.

The results for all wards will be declared by the Returning Officer in **the Café** area at the declaration of results stage area. Candidates, election agents and count agents will be notified via the PA system before results are declared. There will be a pause before the results are declared to allow candidates and agents to move from the hall to the Cafe.

Recount

To give an indication of when a recount might take place, we will be working on the following principles:

Where there is a discrepancy between the verification and counted votes **and** where there is a majority of less than 60 votes, then a request for a recount will likely result in a bundle check being carried out. This involves count assistants flicking through each batch of 100 votes to check none have been sorted incorrectly. Grass skirt summary sheets will also be checked.

Where there is a discrepancy between the verification **and** counted votes and where there is a majority of less than 30 votes then requests for a recount may result in a full recount. A recount would involve count assistants checking each batch of 10 ballot papers to make sure they have been sorted and counted correctly. Grass skirt sheets will also be checked. Adjudicated doubtful ballot papers will not be adjudicated during a recount.

However, it is important to note that recounts are at the sole discretion of the RO. If the verification and count figures reconcile, and the result is clear, it is less likely that she will agree to a request for a recount.

Speeches

Candidate speeches will not be permitted due to the number of contested wards and number of attendees. All candidates will have the opportunity to speak to the media separately after the declaration has been made.

The Council's media manager for the day is Rachel Prance.

Representations

If agents or observers have any concerns about the way in which the count is proceeding, they should contact the Returning Officer, or Deputy Returning Officer, or candidate liaison at the earliest opportunity.

Count conduct

The proper conduct of the election is paramount. Anyone attending must not interfere with or compromise the secrecy of the vote.

There will be a zero tolerance of behaviour that interferes with the effective conduct of the count. Anyone disrupting the verification or count process will be warned. After one warning anyone continuing to disrupt the count will be asked to leave. Security staff and Police will be present at the count and may remove anyone disrupting proceedings.

The RO has allowed candidates to appoint one count agent each. In taking this decision she has balanced the support candidates might need on the day of the count, the importance of transparency of the count, the space available in the hall, and the safety and security of all of those attending.

To assist with allowing larger numbers, the space in the halls has been reconfigured to increase the viewing areas, including opening up the “top tier” seating in the Sports Hall which has a 300 seat capacity. We will also be providing some sheltered seating outside for those who want to take a break away from the halls.

Once the announcement of a result has been made, we will be asking candidates and count agents to leave the count, to assist with managing numbers.

Even with the additional space made available, the halls will likely feel hot and crowded from the start of the count, until a number of results are declared.

Seats will be provided around the sides of the halls, however, to allow larger numbers of people to attend, we will not be able to provide seats for everyone in front of the count tables.

Please can we remind everyone to be respectful of those working at the count. We do understand that this is an extremely important democratic process, where feelings can run high. Please be assured that everyone will be working hard to ensure we deliver accurate results as effectively as possible. Thank you in advance for your politeness and professionalism.

Media

Accredited Media will be present at the count. Only authorised media may film in the count halls, though no filming of ballot papers will be permitted. No other attendees may film in the count halls. Signage will be displayed to advise of this. Staff assigned to liaise with the media are identified by black tabards and Rachel Prance is the media liaison manager. A list of the broadcasters present at the count is included at Appendix 7.

Photography by attendees

Please do not take photos of count staff or ballot papers.

Use of Mobile Phones policy

You are welcome to use mobile phones but please do not take pictures or film any ballot papers. Please keep them on silent.

Announcements

Announcements will be made throughout the proceedings through the PA system.

The times provided in this document give an outline but are only an indication and may change depending on various factors, for example turnout.

Friday 2 May 2025

9am, Verification of Buckinghamshire Council and contested Town and Parish Council areas

From approximately 1pm, Buckinghamshire Council ward counts

Saturday 3 May 2025

9am, Town and Parish Council ward counts

Verification and Count Arrangements

Verification Process

Each count team will verify ballot papers, face up, and count them into 10s with a paperclip and 100s with an elastic band.

Each team will work through each of their allocated polling station ballot boxes. See the ballot box allocation appendix.

Verified ballot papers will be sealed in clear plastic bags and each count team will secure these in their count box, ready for the count.

Everyone attending the verification and count must read the Requirement of Secrecy (on display) and shown at the end of this document.

Counting observers may sit/stand opposite the count staff to observe proceedings but are not permitted to handle the ballot papers. They may inspect the face of any ballot paper, but not the number on the back.

Once all teams have verified the number ballot papers for a ward, a Senior Count Supervisor will share the verification figure with candidates and election agents.

Count Process

There is a requirement for verified polling station ballot papers to be mixed with the ballot papers from at least one other ballot boxes and postal ballot papers, before the sorting of the votes can begin.

The ballot papers will be face up at all times during the count in order to prevent the number or other unique identifying mark on the reverse of the ballot paper being seen.

Count assistants will sort the ballot papers into votes for each candidate. Any doubtful ballot papers will be placed aside for adjudication. Colour trays and count tray labels will indicate the votes on sorted ballot papers. Grass skirts will be used to count votes in multi member wards.

The number of votes for each candidate will be placed into bundles of 10 with a paperclip and 100 with an elastic band.

A Deputy Returning Officer (DRO) will adjudicate doubtful ballot papers. An announcement will be made once the Adjudication is due to take place and agents will be able to see each doubtful ballot paper and the DROs decision. Each ballot paper will be stamped to confirm the decision.

Accepted votes will be taken back to the respective count team and be added to the respective candidate's total votes. A statement of rejected ballot papers will be recorded under the following headings:

- Want of an official mark;
- Voting for more than one candidate;
- Writing or mark by which the voter can be identified;
- Unmarked or void for uncertainty
- Rejected in part

Once the count team has counted the votes on ballot papers for a ward, and all doubtful ballot papers have been adjudicated, a Senior Count will share the provisional figure with candidates and election agents. The Returning Officer will then declare the turnout and verification figure in the Cafe area.

Security Arrangements

It is critical that the secrecy of the vote and the security of the ballot papers are maintained throughout the process. The following arrangements are designed to achieve this.

Check in and security

The safety of those attending the count is of paramount importance.

There will be a Head of Security on site on both days, Gideon Springer on Friday and Vince Grey on Saturday. They will be leading the security team on respective days and will also be the main police liaison officer.

Please report any security concerns to the security team immediately, so that they can be resolved.

All those attending the count will be required to have their bag searched by security staff prior to entry.

There will be a check in desk with staff located outside by the access gate (see Appendix: Site Layout). The main entrance to the Stadium will be closed.

Attendees will need to show photo ID when they confirm their name to check in staff. Only registered attendees with photo ID will be permitted entry to the count. There is no public admission to the count.

Please be aware that, at busy "check in" times, there is likely to be a short delay while searches are undertaken, and ID is checked, please ensure you build time for this delay into your plans for the day.

Once you have been "checked in" please ensure you wear your official count wrist bands or lanyards at all times at the count venue.

As set out above, the count halls will likely be crowded at times, if you are asked to move by security teams to assist with crowd control, please do so.

Security of Votes

Ballot papers will be secured in the ballot box collection area on arrival. These will be overseen at all times by the Elections staff.

Secrecy Requirements

All are required to observe the secrecy requirements – see Appendix 4.

Domestic Arrangements

Toilets

Bowls hall (accessed from outside, opposite tennis courts)

Stadium reception (access via side entrance via gym)

Refreshments

There will be a catered food van on site (by the athletics track), selling hot and cold drinks and sandwiches. You are able to bring your own food and drink, and we would urge you to do so, if you have particular dietary requirements.

Car Parking

There are two car parks which have been made available for the sole use of candidates, agents and count agents. Details of these were provided by way of a travel plan in early April, which is also attached as Appendix 5.

Please note, that there may be a short wait to board the shuttle bus at the Walton Street car park, and another to go through security at the stadium. Please ensure that you leave enough time to get to the count, factoring in these delays as appropriate.

Health and Safety

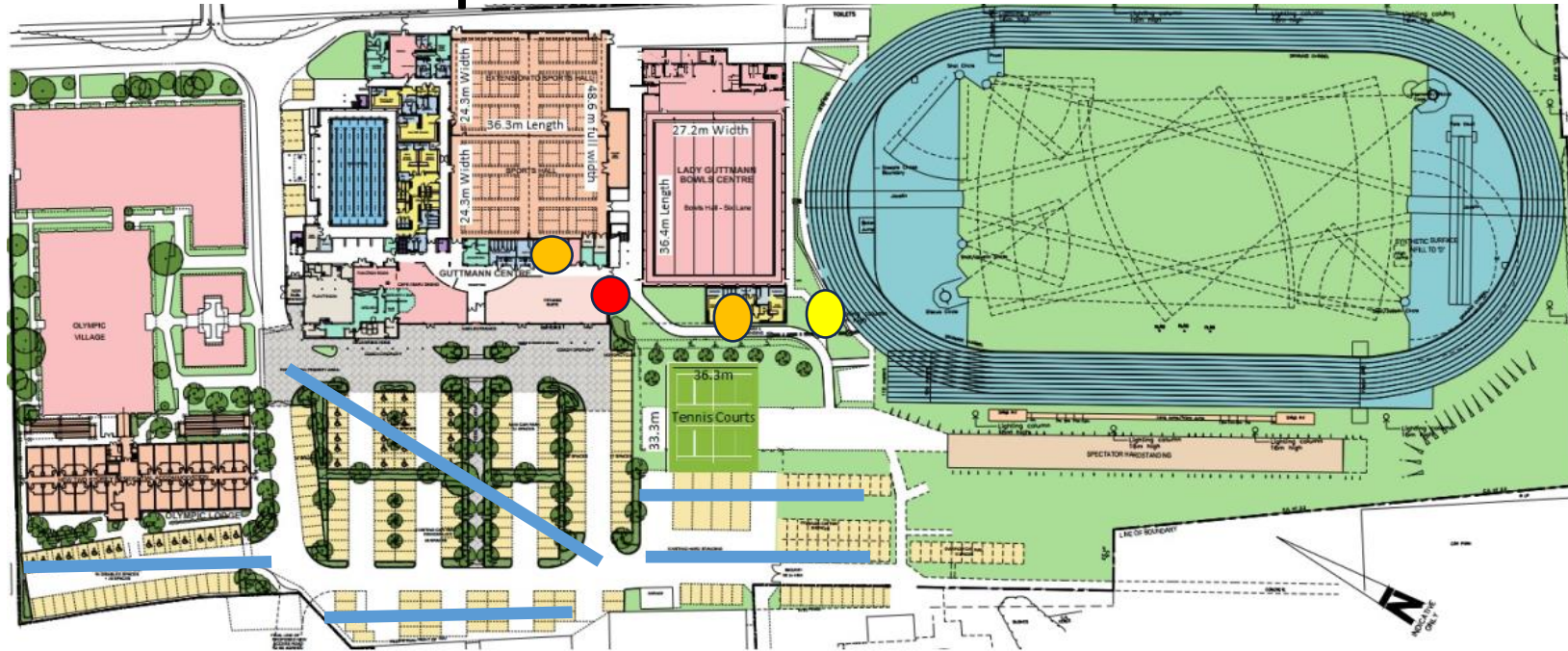
In the event of an evacuation, please leave by the marked fire exit immediately. The building will then be secured.

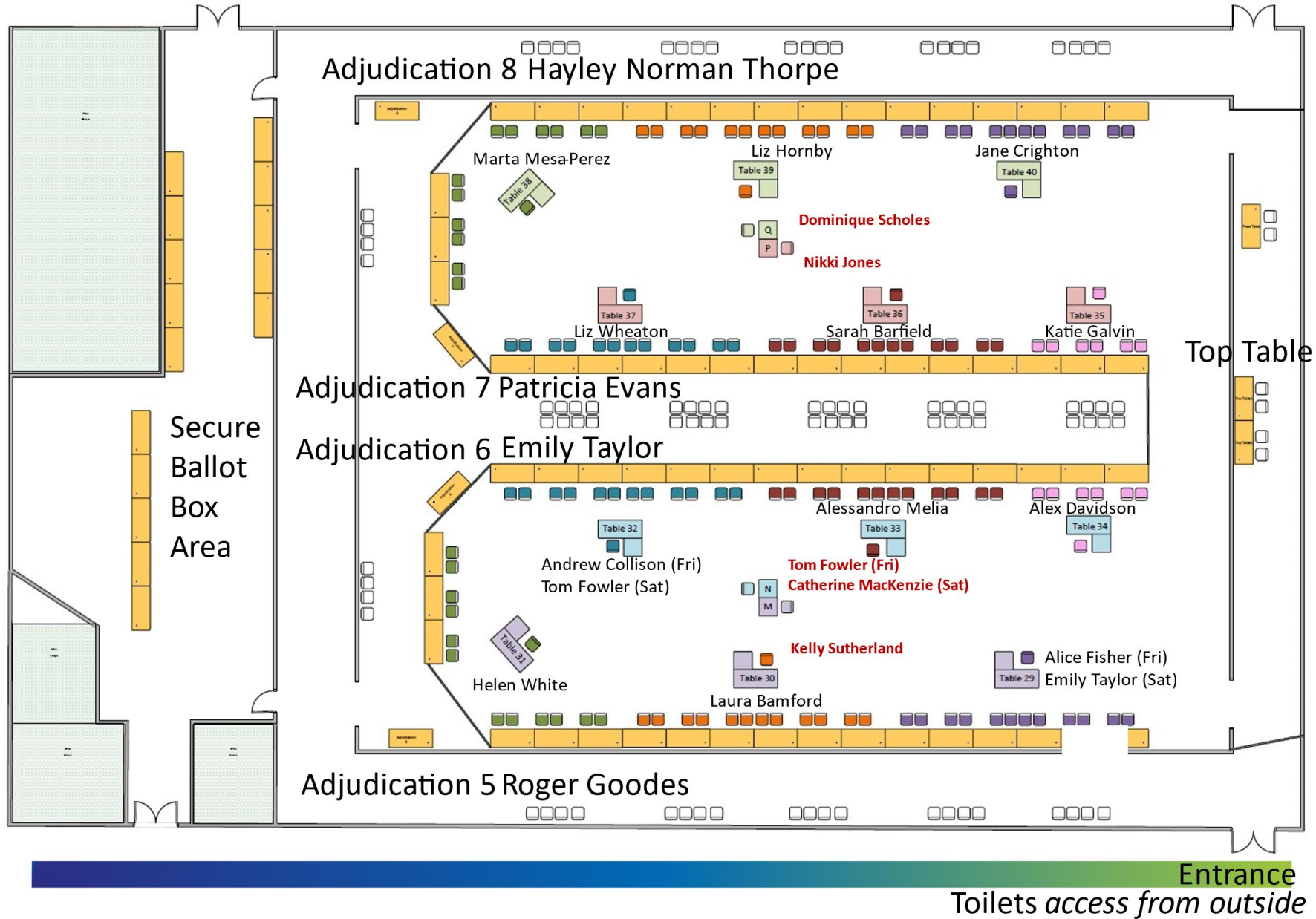

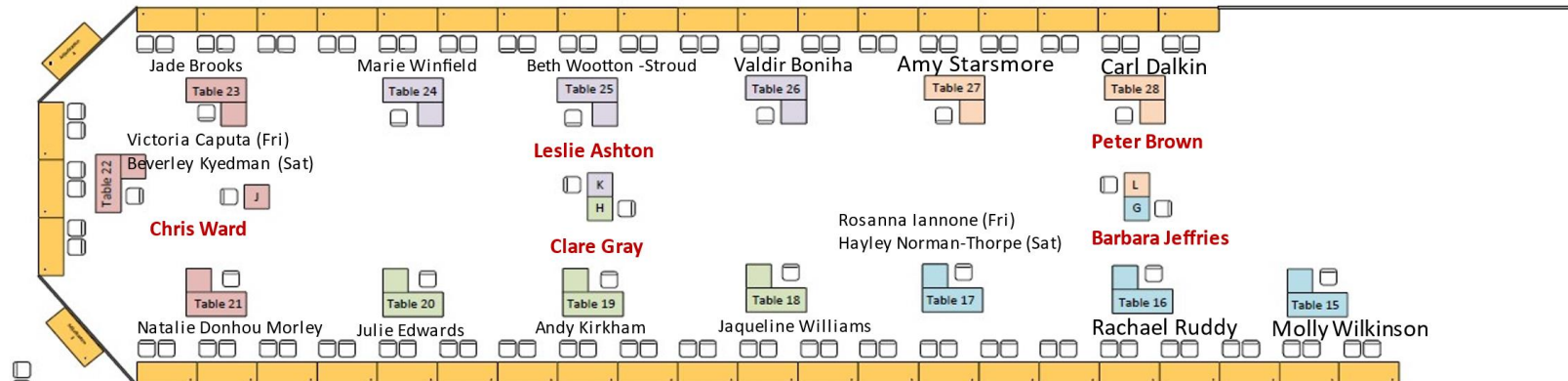


Sports Hall

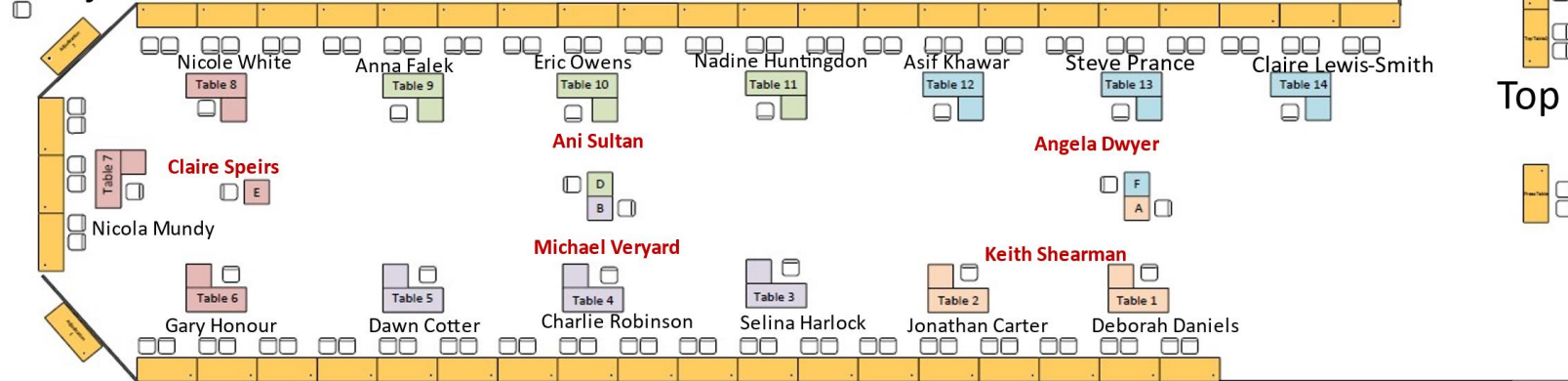

Section 66 of the Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended)

[...]

(2) Every person attending at the counting of the votes shall maintain and aid in maintaining the secrecy of voting and shall not –

(a) ascertain or attempt to ascertain at the counting of the votes the number or other unique identifying mark on the back of any ballot paper;

(b) communicate any information obtained at the counting of the votes as to the candidate for whom any vote is given on any particular ballot paper.

[...]

(6) If a person acts in contravention of this section he shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months.

Appendix 5 – Travel Plan

This document sets out the travel plan for candidates and agents for the 2025 election count.

As you will be aware Buckinghamshire Council will be running a central count for the forthcoming election at Stoke Mandeville Stadium. The Returning Officer has restricted the numbers who will be able to attend the count, to ensure that the count venue stays within the appropriate capacity numbers.

Even with that restriction, we appreciate that there will be a significant amount of people travelling to the Stadium, particularly on Friday afternoon.

We ask, where possible, people to car share, arrange to be dropped off at the venue, walk, cycle or use public transport to access the count.

Car parking is being made available for the use of candidates and agents as follows;

1. Bucks Sports and Social Club (10-minute walk to the central count)
2. Walton Street Car Park (10–15-minute shuttle bus ride to the central count)

As the count will be in the day, the parking which was available during the overnight count for the General Election (i.e. hospital parking) will **not** be an option.

You are able to park at the stadium if you are a registered blue badge holder. Please advise the elections team by emailing elections@buckinghamshire.gov.uk with the blue badge holders name and confirm your name as the Candidate.

Further parking at the Stadium is available only to those who have received a formal Swan Pass in advance, which enables access. Access to the Stadium parking will not be possible without the prior issue of the Swan Pass. If you do not have a Swan Pass, please do not attempt to access the Stadium parking and park at the Bucks Sports and Social Club instead.

Access by bus

The closest bus stop to the venue is located approximately 400m away, accessed on foot via Stadium Approach. A summary of the bus services at this location are included in the table below.

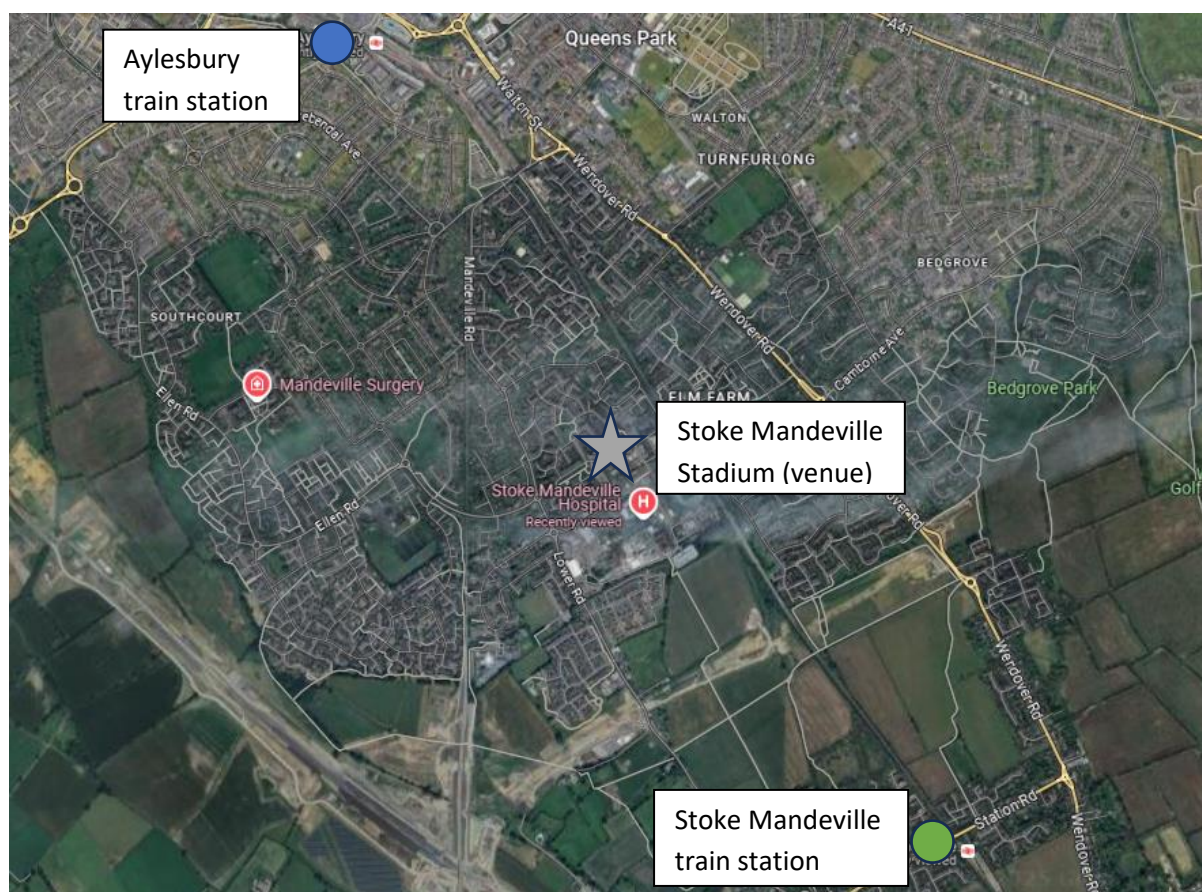

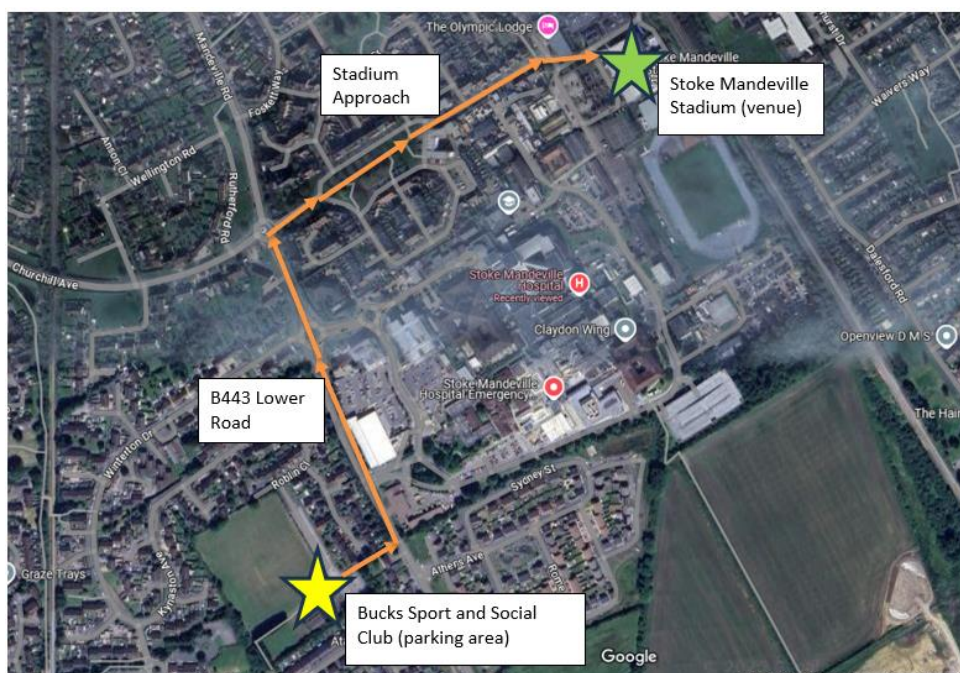
Cycle parking is available outside the front of The Olympic Lodge which neighbours the Stadium as you approach from Stadium Approach.

The Council will be offering a shuttle bus service to and from the Count from 8.15am until the conclusion of the count.

Parking associated with this event is not permitted within the hospital site or within surrounding residential roads.

Only blue badge parking will be available at Stoke Mandeville Stadium.

Alternative public car parks are available across Aylesbury including the following:

 - 130/300 bus service available from Walton Street to the venue
- **Friars square multistorey car park (approx.. 2.8km away)**
