PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

The above Order, made on 17 August 2026 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert the public bridleway running from point A on the Order map at SU86904-91361 in a general east north east direction for approximately 53 metres to point B at SU86948-91384, as shown by a bold continuous line, to a line running from point A at SU86904-91361 in a general east south east direction for approximately 18 metres to point C at SU86922-91359, then north east for approximately 4 metres to point D at SU86926-91361, then east south east for 13 metres to point E at SU86938-91359, then north north east for approximately 10 metres to point F at SU86940-91368, then west north west for approximately 4 metres to point G at SU86937-91370, and then north east for approximately 17 metres to point B at SU86948-91384, as shown by a bold broken line on the Order map and having a width of 2.5 metres throughout.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Reception, Buckinghamshire Council, Walton Street Offices, Walton Street, Aylesbury, HP20 1UA and at High Wycombe Library, 5 Eden Place, High Wycombe, HP11 2DH during normal opening hours. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Definitive Map and Highway Searches Team, 6th Floor, Buckinghamshire Council, Walton Street Offices, Walton Street, Aylesbury, HP20 1UA or email row@buckinghamshire.gov.uk by no later than 2 October 2026. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Buckinghamshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985, this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice open to public inspection.
